CONDITIONS:

- 1. Environment should be kept free from mosquitoes breeding
- 2. Safe drinking water must be provided to all individuals.
- 3. All water storage containers and tanks should be kept tightly closed and maintained clean.
- 4. Septic tank Air pipe should be covered with mosquito net.
- 5. First aid box with necessary medicines should be kept ready for use.
- 6. Hall buildings should be constructed as per the plan approval enclosed with the application and submitted in this office.
- No-objection certificate should be obtained from this office, if any alteration or modification in the existing building and additional building or new building is to be constructed.
- 8. Properly maintain fire safety equipment and educate the employees about its operation.
- 9. The building premises must be kept neat and clean always.
- 10. Toilets and Urinals must be kept hygienically clean
- 11. There shall not be any thatched structure in the premises.
- 12. The building maintenance and repairs should be done then and there immediately.
- 13. Basket for disposal of sanitary napkins should be provided in ladies toilets.
- 14.If any communicable disease or suspected disease is found among the employees in premises, it must be immediately informed to the concerned PHC Medical Officer.
- 15. Sanitary certificate may be cancelled if any discrepancies or deviations are found in future during inspection.
- 16.No smoking area "Smoking here is an offence" signage board to be displayed at prominent places as per COTPA, act 2003.
